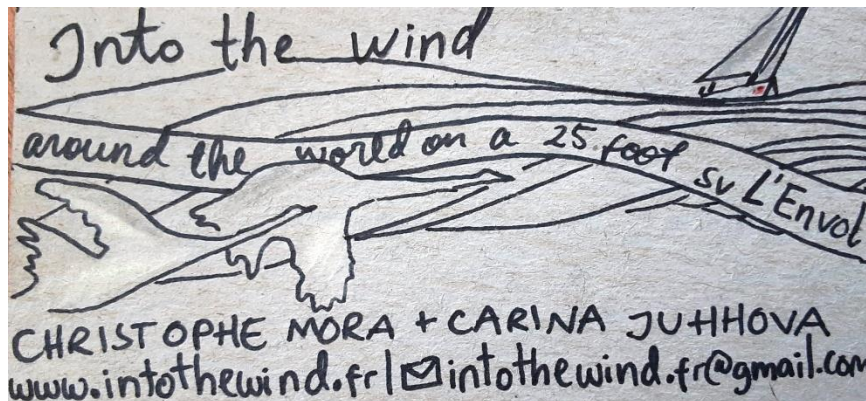

When we first sailed into Beauty Point on November 30, 2020, we were two strangers. Your unconditional hospitality and care, extended to us during our stay, as well as friendship, humour, shared moments of leisure or voluntary effort at the Working Bees and L2H, will journey with us as a manifest of human kindness. Leaving TYC last Tuesday felt like parting from home.

We would like to thank past commodore Greg with Alana Hall for opening the door and taking us in, commodore Roger with Cheryl Hart for providing the shelter of their mooring buoy - our base camp during all this time, rear commodore John with Di Joyce for making us a part of the family by always including and inviting us to every activity in the Beauty Point Clubhouse. Friends from SV Mojo, Richard and Louise, spent hours in the clubhouse repairing our worn out equipment with their sewing machine, including the staysail. Louise also sewed the new lee cloths.

14 months in Beauty Point have passed in a blink of an eye. We had never stayed anywhere that long and letting go of Roger's mooring buoy felt like cutting the umbilical cord - a bitter-sweet moment of rebirth into a journey. Friends came to see us off - that too was new.

You have been a present to us and we still feel your embrace. From the distance we hug you back and wish you open doors and open hearts, all what you have been to us. May someday, somewhere our wakes cross again!
